Option #1 – Lease Transfer

Outgoing Resident FAQ's

- Q. How much is a Lease Transfer?
- A. The current resident will pay a fee equivalent to a half months rent.
- Q. Once a new resident is secured, will I be responsible for any rent that is not paid?
- A. No, the new resident(s) will solely be responsible for all the terms and conditions of the lease
- R. Does MSC help me find a replacement resident?
- A. No, it is the responsibility of the current resident to supply a new resident. There is another option if you wish MSC to secure a new resident for you.
- S. As the current resident, do I get my security deposit back?
- A. All fees remain with the apartment. No fees are refunded. It is up to the discretion of the current resident to determine how they want to handle previous paid fees.
- Q. Do I give the new resident my keys?
- A. No, you will drop off your keys to the Leasing Office before noon on your move-out day. The new resident will pick up keys from the Leasing Office
- Q. What do I do about any outstanding balances?
- A. Prior to signing the Lease Takeover Paperwork, we will not sign a new agreement until all balances are paid and you have a zero balance.
- Q. When can I transfer utilities into my name?
- A. There can be no break in utilities, you can cancel utilities effective deletion date noted on the Lease Transfer addendum.

Incoming Resident FAQ's

- Q. Do I need to fill out an application?
- A. New resident(s) will complete an application and pay the application fee and background check fee if applicable. All incoming residents will be qualified under MSC's current criteria
- B. Will my apartment be turned?
- A. No; however, for an additional ½ month's rent and 8 extra days the apartment can be turned for you. Either the current resident or incoming resident can request this.
- Q. How do I pick up my pick-up keys?
- A. Our maintenance team has 48 hours to change the locks and rekey the apartment. You will pick up a temporary key from the Leasing Office at the start of your transfer and return that key to receive your new keys.
- Q. What do I do about any outstanding balances?
- A. Per the lease transfer addendum any incoming residents assume all responsibility for any outstanding monies owed, existing damages, NSF and/or late fees.
- Q. When can I transfer utilities into my name?
- A. There can be no break in utilities, you can activate the utilities effective the day of the lease transfer noted in the Lease Transfer addendum
- Q. Will I get a copy of the lease?
- A. You will receive a copy of the lease agreement, the policy handbook and all other addenda required for your lease.
- Q. Will I owe any fees when signing the paperwork?
- A. MSC will not be collecting any fees from the incoming resident. However, the current resident may negotiate money transactions at their discretion.
